 - 1. Ryan: No because financial records giveaways.

- d. Commuter Lockers
- i. Chuck: Day use lockers, not being used for that.
 - 1. Not sure if they are even being used for commuters.
 - 2. Changing to lottery system by semester or year.
 - ii. Tommy: Semester people may not use them efficiently.
 - iii. Chuck: Willing to replace mechanism for a pad lock.
 - iv. Louis: People will use their own personal lockers and maybe people did not return keys.
 - v. Callie: Only open up to TRUE commuters (not from local apartments).
 - vi. Tommy: More lockers?
 - 1. Chuck: Hard to find more space, problem with inspections and getting approval.
 - vii. Camille: Get a sign-up for lottery for who really needs the lockers.
 - viii. Chuck: Get people's opinion at commuter lounge to get opinion.
 - ix. Camille: Still accountable for problems.
 - x. Chuck: Feasible to have card swipe but expensive.
 - xi. Amanda: Lottery system is counterproductive; sign out on daily/monthly/weekly use; First come first serve.
 - 1. Jon: People will go out of their way to use it.

 - v. Camille: By taking 10 posters is going to take up 80; much room that others can't organize.

 - viii. Camille: Not feasible to take more than 4.
 - ix. Tom: Keep 4, upper be 2 sizes smaller.

 4. Jon: Limit SUBOG to semester poster.
